



Flower Parts

Petals-the colorful part of the flower that attracts insects by sight and scent

Sepals-leaflike structures that make up the flower's calyx

Stamens-the male reproductive part of the flower made up of the anther and stamen

Anther-the part of the stamen that produces pollen

Filament-the stalk of the stamen

Pistil-the female part of the flower made up of the stigma, style, and ovary

Stigma-the top of the pistil where the pollen grains enter the pistil

Style-the connection between the stigma and the ovary

Ovary- base of the pistil with five sections each containing two ovules, which become seeds
